Color Blocked Scarf in Tango

SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

One Size

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 56½" Width: 7½"

MATERIALS

Universal Yarn Tango (82% cotton, 18% polyamide; 50g/153 yds)

- 102 Moliente (A) 1 ball
- 101 Buenos Aires (B) 2 balls
- 108 Calesita (C) 1 ball

Needle: US Size 8 (5 mm) or size needed

to obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in garter stitch Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

What's not to love about a chic color-blocked scarf? Knit in our fabulous new yarn, Tango, this accessory has a fun texture you'll adore. This modern piece will carry you from fall to spring.

The scarf is knit flat modularly. First, you work the longest portion in two stripes horizontally. Then, you pick up stitches on each end and create an additional two stripes.

PATTERN BEGINS

SCARF

Section 1

With color A, cast on 170 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit. Row 2 (WS): Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 3¾" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row. Change to color B. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 7½" from cast-on edge. Bind off all sts.

Section 2

With RS facing, starting on either narrow end of scarf and using color C, pick up and knit 38 sts evenly across.

Row 1 (WS): Knit. Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 6¼" from pickedup edge. Change to color B. Rep Rows 1-2 until piece meas 8¾" from picked up edge. Bind off all sts.

Section 3

With RS facing, starting on opposite narrow end of scarf and using color C, pick up and knit 38 sts evenly across.


Complete as for Section 2. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

garter stknit every rowmeasmeasuresRSright sidest(s)stitch(es)WSwrong side



* Arrows indicate direction of knitting.
