



## Pattern Collection: Accessories



### **Deluxe Socks**

Designed by Universal Yarn Design Team

### **DIFFICULTY**

Easy

### **SIZE**

Adult Medium

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

**Foot Circumference:** 8"

**Length:** Adjustable

### **MATERIALS**

**Universal Yarn *Deluxe Stripes*** (75% superwash wool, 25% nylon, 100g/218yds)

- 307 Timber – 1 skein

**Needles:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 6 (4 mm) set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences)

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

### **GAUGE**

20 sts x 28 rnds = 4" Stockinette stitch (St st) with larger ndl

**Save time, check your gauge.**

*Knit. Relax. Smile. Repeat!*

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## PATTERN NOTES

Stripey and simple, the Deluxe Socks will keep you cozy all winter long! These socks would be an ideal first sock project and knit up satisfyingly fast. Knit in self-striping Deluxe Stripes, these socks are fun without the work of managing multiple colors of yarn.

Prefer a solid color? Be sure to try Deluxe Worsted Superwash, which has the same gauge as Deluxe Stripes!

These socks are knit from the cuff down with a heel flap and gusset.

## STITCH GUIDE

### K2, P2 Rib

*(multiple of 4 sts)*

**Rnd 1:** \* K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

## SOCKS

### Cuff

With smaller ndl, cast on 40 sts.

Work in K2, P2 Rib until piece meas 2" from cast-on edge. Change to larger ndl.

### Leg

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

Cont in St st until piece meas 5 (5¼, 5½)", or desired length, from cast-on edge.

### Heel Flap

*Note: You will now begin working in rows.*

**Set-up Rnd:** K20 Instep sts, place these sts on holder or waste yarn. Work over next 20 Heel sts as follows:

**Row 1 (RS):** [Sl 1, k1] 10 times, turn work.

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl 1, p19, turn work.

Rep Rows 1-2, 9 more times.

### Heel Turn

**Row 1 (RS):** Sl 1, k12, ssk, k1, turn work.

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl 1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn work.

**Row 3:** Sl 1, knit to 1 st bef gap, ssk, k1, turn work.

**Row 4:** Sl 1, purl to 1 st bef gap, p2tog, p1, turn work.

Rep Rows 3-4 until all sts have been worked – 14 sts rem.

### Gusset

**Set-up Rnd:** K14, pick up and knit 11 sts along Heel Flap, pm to denote new bor, k20 Instep sts, pm, pick up and knit 11 sts along side of Heel Flap, pm, knit to end – 56 sts.

**Dec Rnd:** Knit to 2 m, sl m, ssk, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog – 2 sts dec'd, 54 sts rem.

**Even Rnd:** Knit.

Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd, 7 more times – 14 sts dec'd, 40 sts rem. Rearrange sts evenly among ndls – 20 Instep sts and 20 Heel (bottom of foot) sts.

### Foot

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

Cont in St st until Foot meas approx. 7" or 2" less than desired length, measuring from back of Heel.

### Toe

**Dec Rnd:** \* K1, ssk, knit to 2 sts bef m, k2tog, sl m; rep from \* to end – 4 sts dec'd, 36 sts rem.

**Even Rnd:** Knit.

Rep Dec Rnd and Even Rnd, 6 more times – 24 sts dec'd, 12 sts rem.

Place first 6 sts on one ndl and last 6 sts on separate ndl. Graft the two sets of sts together using Kitchener stitch.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

<b>bef</b>	before
<b>bor</b>	beginning of round
<b>cont</b>	continue
<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>dpn(s)</b>	double pointed needle(s)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
<b>m</b>	marker
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>ndl</b>	needle
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>p2tog</b>	purl 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>pm</b>	place marker
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat
<b>rnd</b>	round
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>sl</b>	slip
<b>ssk</b>	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>WS</b>	wrong side



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
