



## Pattern Collection: Accessories

### SIZE

One

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Wingspan:** 58½"

**Depth at Center:** 23"

### MATERIALS

**Fibra Natura Lina** (68% linen, 32% cotton;  
100g/252 yds)

- 110 Potting Soil (A) – 1 skein
- 107 Lavandula (B) – 1 skein
- 108 Crocus (C) – 1 skein

*Note: The sample shown took up nearly all of colors A & B. If your gauge is inaccurate it will affect the amount of yarn used. If in doubt, purchase an additional skein each of Colors A & B.*

**Needles:** US Size 5 (3.75 mm) straight or size needed to obtain gauge

US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 40" circular (to accommodate large number of sts)

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers, 2 removable stitch markers

### GAUGE

22 sts x 34 rows = 4" in Stripes Pattern with larger ndl

**Save time check your gauge.**

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## PATTERN NOTES

At first glance, Emri looks like a triangular shawl. Which it is! But there are several fun and unusual components to this project.

First, the stitch pattern in Emri is striped, but with a fun twist. Every four rows a “dip” stitch is made, blending two colors together.

Second, Emri has an interesting construction. The center section is worked from the top down. The “wings” are picked up from the center section and worked outward.

And third, to finish things off, stitches are picked up along the bottom edge and worked in a sequence of garter stripes. The design is finished with a tidy I-cord bind off in a contrasting color. For your convenience a diagram is included that illustrates the construction of this pattern.

When working in Stripes Pattern, do not break yarn at the end of each stripe. Instead, twist the strands of yarn around one another every RS row.

## STITCH GUIDE

**Central Double Decrease (CDD)** On the purl side, sl 2 sts tog pwise tbl, p1, p2sso.

**Dip Stitch (Dip)** Insert needle in front of stitch in the 4th row below the next st on the LH ndl and draw through a loose loop; sl the loop onto the LH ndl and k2tog tbl (i.e., the loop and the next stitch).

### I-Cord Bind-Off

Cast on 3 sts to first st on left ndl using knitted cast-on. \* K2, k2tog tbl (1 st bound off), slip these 3 sts back to left ndl; rep from \* until all sts have been bound off. Bind off rem 3 I-Cord sts.

### Stripes Pattern

*(repeat of 4 stitches, plus 3)*

**Row 1 (RS):** With A, k1, \* Dip, k3; rep from \* to last 2 sts, Dip, k1.

**WS Rows 2 & 4:** With A, purl.

**Row 3:** With A, knit.

**Row 5:** With B, k1, \* Dip, k3; rep from \* to last 2 sts, Dip, k1.

**WS Rows 6 & 8:** With B, purl.

**Row 7:** With B, knit.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

## SHAWL

With Color A and larger ndl, cast on 71 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (WS):** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2, 2 more times.

### Establish Pattern

Work Rows 1-8 of Stripes Pattern, joining color B as indicated on chart or written instructions.

Cont in patt as est'd, repeating rows 1-8 of Stripes Pattern until piece meas 13” from cast-on edge and ending with a WS row. Place removable marker on each side of Shawl to denote beg of Left and Right Wing pick-up.

### Shape Tip

**Dec Row (RS):** K1, ssk, cont in patt as est'd to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 2 sts dec'd, 69 sts rem.

**Even Row (WS):** Cont in patt as est'd to end.

Rep last 2 rows, 32 more times, then rep Dec row, 1 more time – 64 sts dec'd, 3 sts rem.

**Next Row:** CDD – 2 sts dec'd, 1 st rem.

Fasten off rem st.

### Left Wing

*Note: Read through the entire section before proceeding, establishing Stripes Pattern and shaping occur at the same time.*

With Color A, larger ndl, and RS facing, beg at removable m, pick up and knit 71 sts evenly bet removable m and cast-on edge.

**Set-up Row (WS):** K4, pm, work in Stripes Pattern to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit to m, sl m, k1, ssk, work Row 3 of Stripes Pattern to m, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 70 sts rem.

**Rows 2-4:** Knit to m, sl m, cont in Pattern as est'd to m, sl m, knit to end.

**Dec Row (RS):** Knit to m, sl m, k1, ssk, cont as est'd to m, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 69 sts rem.

**Even Row (WS):** Knit to m, sl m, cont in patt as est'd to m, sl m, knit to end.

Rep Dec Row every RS row 58 more times – 58 sts dec'd, 11 sts rem.

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### Final Shaping

**Row 1:** K4, sl m, k1, ssk, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 10 sts rem. *Note: Remove markers as you come to them.*

**Row 2:** K4, p2, k4.

**Row 3:** K4, sl m, k1, ssk, k3 – 9 sts rem.

**Row 4:** K3, p2, k4.

**Row 5:** K4, sl m, k1, ssk, k2 – 8 sts rem.

**Row 6:** K2, p2, k4.

**Row 7:** K4, sl m, k1, ssk, k1 – 7 sts rem.

**Row 8:** K1, p2, k4

**Row 9:** K4, sl m, k1, ssk – 6 sts rem.

**Row 10:** P2, k4.

**Row 11:** K4, ssk – 5 sts rem.

**Row 12:** K5.

**Row 13:** K3, ssk – 4 sts rem.

**Row 14:** K4.

**Row 15:** K2, ssk – 3 sts rem.

**Row 16:** K3.

**Row 17:** K1, ssk – 2 sts rem.

**Row 18:** K2.

**Row 19:** Ssk.

Fasten off rem st.

### Right Wing

*Note: Read through the entire section before proceeding, establishing Stripes Pattern and shaping occur at the same time.*

With Color A, larger ndl, and RS facing, beg at cast-on edge, pick up and knit 71 sts evenly bet cast-on edge and removable m.

**Set-up Row (WS):** K4, pm, work in Stripes Pattern to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit to m, sl m, work Row 3 of Stripes Pattern to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 70 sts rem.

**Rows 2-4:** Knit to m, sl m, work next row of Stripes Pattern to m, sl m, knit to end.

**Dec Row:** Knit to m, sl m, cont in patt as est'd to 3 sts bef m, k2tog, k1, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 69 sts rem.

**Even Row:** Knit to m, sl m, cont in patt as est'd to m, sl m, knit to end.

Rep Dec Row every RS row 58 more times – 58 sts dec'd, 11 sts rem.

### Final Shaping

**Row 1:** K4, sl m, k2tog, k1, sl m, knit to end – 1 st dec'd, 10 sts rem. *Note: Remove markers as you come to them.*

**Row 2:** K4, p2, k4.

**Row 3:** K3, k2tog, k1, sl m, k4 – 9 sts rem.

**Row 4:** K4, p2, k3.

**Row 5:** K2, k2tog, k1, sl m, k4 – 8 sts rem.

**Row 6:** K4, p2, k2.

**Row 7:** K1, k2tog, k1, sl m, k4 – 7 sts rem.

**Row 8:** K4, p2, k1.

**Row 9:** K2tog, k1, sl m, k4.

**Row 10:** K4, p2.

**Row 11:** K2tog, k4 – 5 sts rem.

**Row 12:** K5.

**Row 13:** K2tog, k3 – 4 sts rem.

**Row 14:** K4.

**Row 15:** K2tog, k2 – 3 sts rem.

**Row 16:** K3.

**Row 17:** K2tog, k1 – 2 sts rem.

**Row 18:** K2.

**Row 19:** K2tog.

Fasten off rem st.

### Edging

With C, smaller ndl, and RS facing, beg at tip of Right Wing – pick up and knit 140 sts evenly along bottom right edge, pm, pick up and knit 1 st at the center tip, pm, pick up and knit 140 sts along bottom left edge – 280 sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** K4, m1, knit to m, sl m, p1, sl m, knit to last 4 sts, m1, k4 – 2 sts inc'd, 281 sts.

**Row 2 (RS):** K4, m1, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to last 4 sts, m1, k4 – 4 sts inc'd, 285 sts.

**Row 3:** Rep Row 1 – 2 sts inc'd, 287 sts. Change to B.

**Row 4:** With B, k4, m1, knit to m, yo, sl m, k1, sl m, yo, knit to last 4 sts, m1, k4 – 4 sts inc'd, 291 sts.

**Row 5:** With B, rep Row 1 – 2 sts inc'd, 293 sts. Change to A.

**Row 6:** With A, rep Row 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 297 sts.

**Row 7:** With A, rep Row 1 – 2 sts inc'd, 299 sts. Break A.

**Row 8:** With B, rep Row 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 303 sts.

**Row 9:** With B, rep Row 1 – 2 sts inc'd, 305 sts. Break B.

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**Row 10:** With C, rep Row 2 – 4 sts inc'd, 309 sts.  
**Row 11:** With C, rep Row 1 – 2 sts inc'd, 311 sts.  
 With C, loosely bind off all sts using the I-cord method.

**FINISHING**

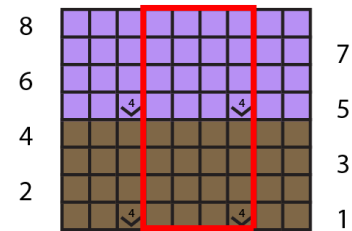
Block piece to finished measurements and weave in ends.

**Abbreviations**

- bef** before
- beg** begin(ning)
- bet** between
- cont** continue
- est'd** established
- k** knit
- k2tog** knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
- m** marker
- m1** insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
- meas** measures
- ndl** needle
- p** purl
- patt** pattern
- pm** place marker
- psso** pass slipped stitch(es) over
- pwise** purlwise

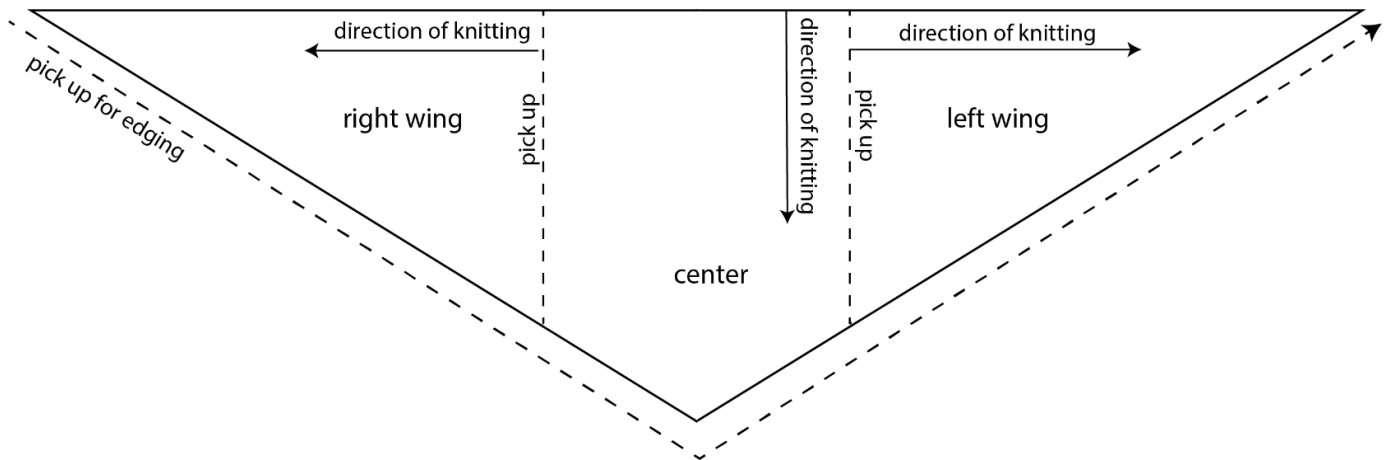
- rem** remain(ing)
- rep** repeat
- RS** right side
- sl** slip
- ssk** slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
- st(s)** stitch(es)
- tbl** through the back loop(s)
- tog** together
- WS** wrong side

**Stripes Pattern**



**Key**

- with A: knit on RS, purl on WS
- with A: Dip st
- with B: knit on RS, purl on WS
- with B: Dip st
- pattern repeat



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
