



GAUGE: 17 sts = 4" in St st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.

HAT

Cast on 39 (43, 47) sts, leaving 20" long tail for sewing seam.

Row 1 (WS): P1, *k1, p1; repeat from * across.

Row 2: K1, *p1, k1; repeat from * across.

Repeat rows 1-2 for 1½".

Change to stockinette stitch. Work even until piece measures 13½ (15½, 17½)" from beginning. Work rows 1-2 for 1½". Bind off loosely. Cut yarn leaving 20" long tail for sewing seam.

Fold piece in half. Use each yarn end to sew each side seam, starting at the ribbing and sewing toward the folded top.

ABBREVIATIONS: k = knit; mm = millimeters, p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; * or ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.

Two-Pointed Hat

If you're looking for a hat that looks great and is easy to knit, this one's for you! Knit as a flat piece with no involved shaping, even a beginner will enjoy this one.
